Entry Requirements

- Must be a registered staff nurse/medical assistant, preferably with 6 months working experience in a haemodialysis unit
- Must have full secondment and a form of endorsement from their relevant authority
- Hepatitis Status – must be negative

Course subjects

- Applied renal physiology
- Principles of dialysis
- Haemodialysis procedure and nursing care
- Infection control
- Dietary aspects and chronic haemodialysis
- Rehabilitative aspects on chronic haemodialysis
- Ethical issues in dialysis
- Principles of management
- Counselling skills
- Water treatment and its short-term and long-term complications

The course was first conducted in June 2005. Till today, a total of 94 Staff Nurses and Medical Assistants have completed the course.

- Clinical experience will be gained primarily at NKF centres under local preceptors.

- Visit to a water treatment plant and an RO water treatment system factory.
